Junior Curlers,

The United States Curling Association will hold its third annual Rice Lake junior curling camp on August 17-20, 2006. The program is aimed at juniors with competitive curling experience and/or who have attended a regular USCA summer curling camp. All attendees must be registered with the USCA.

The camp will provide young curlers with a wonderful opportunity to develop their curling skills and understanding of the game. The camp will be held at the Rice Lake Curling Club. The staff for the camp will include top U.S. coaches and instructors.

All transportation during the camp will be by school bus only-the use of cars by campers is not permitted. Classroom and on-ice activities will take place at the Rice Lake Curling Club. Accommodations will be at the Microtel, Rice Lake.

Besides the development of his or her skills, each camper will meet other young people who love the sport and wish to improve. Many friendships will be developed, and the possibility of forming new teams always exists. These are young curlers who will continue to meet and compete with each other for years to come.

Space for this year's camp is limited to 32 curlers and we expect to be filled. Be sure to submit your application early.

SELECTION OF ATTENDEES

A selection committee on the basis of the curling resumes submitted on the application form will select camp attendees. The curlers will be selected as individuals not teams.

CAMP FEE & PAYMENT POLICY

- The fee for the camp is \$175.00 and must accompany the application
- Fee includes all meals, accommodations, local transportation & instruction
- The deposit check date must be the same as the date on the application
- Postdate checks will **not** be accepted
- Checks will only be deposited when the applicant is accepted into the camp
- If a curler is not accepted into the camp, the deposit check will be returned
- If a curler is placed on the "wait list," the deposit check will be held until a spot opens up
- Curlers are **not** automatically registered for the Eau Claire Camp. You must complete the appropriate registration form for each camp
- Applicants must have completed the 9th grade to be eligible to register for the Rice Lake camp
