



WORLD SENIOR CURLING CHAMPIONSHIPS 2013 (WSCC)

FREDERICTON, NB, CANADA 13 - 20 April 2013

Final Draft: 17 January 2013

1. World Curling Federation (WCF) rules apply, unless otherwise indicated below or explained at the Team Meeting (12 April, Grant-Harvey Centre, 10:30).
2. The Senior Women (14 teams) will be in two groups and each group will play a single round-robin series. At the end of the round-robin series, and tie-breaker games (if required, one session), the team ranked 1st in WA - Yellow group plays the team ranked 2nd in the WB - Rose group in one semifinal and the team ranked 2nd in WA plays the team ranked 1st in the WB in the other semifinal. The winners of the semifinals play in the Gold medal game, and the losers of the semifinals play in the Bronze medal game.
3. The Senior Men (20 teams) will be in two groups and each group will play a single round-robin series. At the end of the round-robin series, and tie-breaker games (if required, one session), the team ranked 1st in the MA - White group plays the team ranked 2nd in the MB - Blue group in one semifinal and the team ranked 2nd in the MA plays the team ranked 1st in the MB in the other semifinal. The winners of the semifinals play in the Gold medal game, and the losers of the semifinals play in the Bronze medal game.
4. All games will be eight (8) ends, with extra end(s) to break tied games.
5. There will be a six (6) minute practice for each team before each round-robin game. The practice starts 20 minutes before the scheduled game time. The team with the first practice during the round robin will be the team with dark stones for all the women's games, and for all the men's games, except a coin toss will be required to determine which team practices first for the MA (white) group games at 8:30 on Sunday (14th) and the CZE v LAT game at 15:30 on Friday (19th); and the MB (blue) group games on Saturday (13th) at 8:30.
6. At the conclusion of the team's pre-game practice, one player delivers one stone to the tee at the home end. The team with the lesser Last Stone Draw (LSD) distance has the choice of delivering first or second stone in the first end. If the LSDs are equal, a toss of the coin will determine which team has the choice.
7. First named team in each draw plays stones with dark coloured handles, and should wear dark coloured upper playing garments. Note: red is considered a dark colour.
8. The Chief Umpire will determine the schedule and ice for all post round-robin games as soon as the number of games required and the opponents have been determined. Please note that the semi-finals and finals will be played in the Mixed Doubles venue, and special practice on that ice will be arranged on Friday (19th) evening.
9. **NOTE:** There will only be one round for tie-breaker games. The procedure for reducing the number of teams will be explained at the Team Meeting.
