Year to Date Order of Merit as of December 21st.

The USCA Championships Rules for 2010-2011 stipulates that two men’s teams and two women’s teams will advance to the USCA National Championships in Fargo, ND based on the World Curling Tour “Year-To-Date” Order of Merit as of the conclusion of the Curl Mesabi Cash Spiel on December 19th.

Based on the Order of Merit points listed on the World Curling Tour website and confirmed by the USA Curling VP of Competitive Programs, Pete Fenson with 20.47 OOM points and Tyler George with 14.6 OOM points have accumulated the highest number of Year-To-Date OOM points and will advance directly to the USCA National Championships in Fargo, ND.

Based on the Order of Merit points listed on the World Curling Tour website and confirmed by the USA Curling VP of Competitive Programs, Erika Brown with 24 OOM points and Allison Pottinger with 5 OOM points have accumulated the highest number of Year-To-Date OOM points and will advance directly to the USCA National Championships in Fargo, ND.
